

# 4D AJAX FOR DREAMWEAVER DEMO

## READ ME

This is a demo for the 4D Ajax for Dreamweaver extension.

## REQUIREMENTS



4th Dimension 2004.6



4D Ajax.mxp



Dreamweaver CS3

Install the '4D Ajax' extension to Dreamweaver CS3 (instructions are found in section *Installation* of the 4D Ajax for Dreamweaver Guide).

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Launch the *Demo*.
- 2) Launch Dreamweaver CS3. In Dreamweaver browse and open one of the following.

- [CALENDAR.HTML](#)
- [DATATREE.HTML](#)
- [IMAGEMATRIX.HTML](#)

These files can be found in the 'dax' folder next to the *Demo*.

- 3) Next step is to "Import the structure and then enter login information".

- **IMPORT THE STRUCTURE:**


- a) Click the Import Structure button. 
- b) Browse for the Support folder found in the Extras folder next to the Demo.

- **ENTER LOGIN INFORMATION:**

- a) Click the Insert Login button. 
- b) Enter "Guest" for User. Enter "4D" for password.

- 4) Follow the remaining steps on the HTML page.

For reference, here is a snapshot of the 4D Ajax Toolbar in Dreamweaver.



- 5) Test the page by entering the appropriate path in your web browser (based on the file chosen in Step 2):

- <http://localhost:8080/calendar.html>

- <http://localhost:8080/datatree.html>
- <http://localhost:8080/imagematrix.html>

6) Go back to Step 2. Choose a different HTML page and repeat this process until all files have been chosen.

## MODIFYING THE SELECTIONS


You can modify the Selections (ie. Tables and Views) in this database by connecting to <http://localhost:8080/index.html> in your web browser.

For more information on how to do this, see the *4D Ajax Framework Admin Reference* found at <http://www.4d.com/support/documentation.html>.

These modifications would update the files found in the Support folder within the Extras folder (typically found next to your database). However, since this demo is a merged application the updated Extras folder is not next to the database.

On Mac the updated Extras folder is found in:

- Demo -> Contents -> Database -> Extras



To navigate this path you must first right click the Demo and select "Show Package Contents".

Dreamweaver is unable to navigate past the Demo when you want to re-import your structure. Thus, it would be best that you copy the updated Extras folder to an accessible location (such as next to Demo) for Dreamweaver to import.

On PC the updated Extras folder is found in:

- Database -> Extras

This Extras folder does not need to be copied to another location since this path is accessible by Dreamweaver on this platform.
